At the National Concrete Masonry Association, Greenwald headed the Research and Development Laboratory and directed the research, testing and general functions of the laboratory.

Greenwald is a registered professional engineer in Virginia. He earned a Master of Civil Engineering degree from the University of Delaware and a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Maine. He graduated from the Institute for Organizational Management with a certificate in Nonprofit Organization Management and is a Certified Association Executive (CAE). Greenwald is a member of the American Society of Civil Engineers, American Society of Association Executives and ASTM. Greenwald has authored numerous journal articles and was awarded the ASTM Alan H. Yorkdale Memorial Award for 2004 and 2005.
